Dear Friends of Jacob,

Our son, Jacob Neil, passed away due to SIDS on February 23, 2006 at ten weeks of age. With the assistance of our friends and family, we created a foundation to honor his memory: The Jacob Neil Boger Foundation is dedicated to promoting children's health by supporting pediatric medical research and treatment efforts.

The Jacob Neil Boger Foundation has continued its careful stewardship of your donations in our 5<sup>th</sup> year! Through the generosity of our donors and the hard work of our dedicated volunteers, we have continued our efforts to find better detection methods and treatment for SIDS and other pediatric illnesses.

We support SIDS research through our direct support of Dr. Kinney's lab at **Children's Hospital of Boston**, and we continue to grow the **Jacob Neil Boger SIDS Research endowed fund** with that organization to benefit SIDS research for years to come. We contributed again to **Children's Neuroblastoma Cancer Fund** for pediatric cancer research; and we are very proud to have completed our \$25,000 pledge over 5 years to **Arnold Palmer Children's Hospital**, directed specifically to the pediatric ICU. We are renewing the pledge to the ICU where Jacob spent his last hours and received skilled and compassionate care.

We again contributed to the **Progeria Research Foundation**, which is making incredible strides towards finding the causes of Progeria and a possible cure. We have also completed our \$40,000 pledge over four years to fund a scholarship at the new **UCF Medical School**. All of this is accomplished with negligible overhead, meaning nearly all of your generous contributions go directly to those we serve. In total we have disbursed over \$150,000 in the past 5 years! All of these efforts help to further our mission and honor our son, Jacob.

We are pleased to announce the **6th** Annual Jacob Neil Boger Golf Tournament has been scheduled for **October 22, 2011** at Orange County National Golf Center!
